(Numbers refer to sections overleaf)

At least seven days notice is required before the first reading of banns.

(2) If either of you will not be 18 by the proposed date of the wedding, the priest will need to know whether the consent of parents or guardians has been obtained.

(4) Make sure you include the name of the town, county and postcode

(6) This means the Church of England parish in which you *live*. If either of you lives in a different parish from that in which the marriage is to take place, you have to arrange for the banns to be read there too and obtain a banns certificate. To check your parish enter your postcode in <http://www.achurchnearyou.com/> your local parish should be listed here. If in doubt contact St. Mary's Office.

The Church of England Fee for having your Banns read in 2019 is £44.
