## **Saying Goodbye**

This service will be held in Winchester Cathedral on **Saturday 13th May at 10.30am** for those who have lost babies at any stage of pregnancy, at birth, or in early years, or who has been affected by a family member's or friend's loss. Whether the loss was recent or 80 years ago, everyone is welcome to attend.

This is also a service for anyone who is grieving the fact that they haven't had children. This may be due to circumstance, infertility or for other reasons but all are welcome. Babies and children are also invited to come with their families, as the Saying Goodbye Service is a family event for all. This is organised by the Mariposa Trust, a UK charity which supports those who have lost babies at any stage of pregnancy, at birth, or in infancy.

### **Christian Aid Week - 14th to 20th May**

As part of our Eco Church work we are supporting Christian Aid Week with a collection in church. This is the 60th year of Christian Aid week and provides significant funds to the charity to enable it to provide assistance to those across the world in need. Last year Christian Aid week helped a Bangladeshi woman whose home was constantly flooded. Her home has been rebuilt with support from Christian Aid and she said the following, "Last year when you came to my home we were knee deep in water. ## New preparation process for Baptisms at St. Mary's

In March 2017, the PCC gave full support to a proposal to introduce a new baptism preparation process, whereby prospective baptism families will come to an All Age Service for initial discussions with designated Baptism Team Members, then attend a revamped Baptism Preparation Evening, leading to baptisms at an All Age Service.

This reflects our parish Mission Action Plan (pMAP), which includes under SHARE: "Prepare and begin delivery of a new baptism outreach initiative."

The new scheme is planned to begin in September 2017, in order to allow time to make the necessary preparations and adjustments. One key change is that baptisms will normally take place during the All Age Service on the first Sunday of the month. Baptisms will be planned so that the total number of anticipated guests will not swamp the regular fellowship: in the event of a very large baptism party, alternative arrangements will be made.

In each of the last few years, around 1500 people have attended baptisms on Sunday afternoons. This represents a tremendous opportunity for outreach. The intention is to establish a large group of Baptism Team Members who will help and guide prospective baptism families through the process, so that parents make informed decisions, including whether to proceed with a baptism, as well as in the choice of godparents.

Please would you consider volunteering as a Baptism Team Member? In pairs, your role will be to have an initial chat (aided by a checklist) with prospective baptism families after an All Age Service which they will be expected to attend. Ideally, Baptism Team Members will also attend the Baptism Preparation Evening and the baptism itself.

Training will be given at **on Wednesday 14th June at 7.30pm in the Church Centre**, when more information will be highlighted and discussed.

As Baptism is an important part of our Christian journey, this is a wonderful opportunity for anyone in the fellowship to engage with those seeking baptism for their children. ### Children and Families Leaders
